In response to an e-mail from your office, Nebraska is resubmitting our Transfer Authority waiver request. It has been revised to now reflect 50% transfer authority between the two funding streams. More detail has been added to the Programmatic Outcomes section explaining how useful this waiver has been to all three of the local areas in Nebraska. The revisions are highlighted.

Nebraska has not used the waiver allowing local area formula funds to provide incumbent worker training. With the current economic conditions, the State has decided not to resubmit a request for this waiver at this time.
