PURPOSE:

To provide the adjusted amounts of WIA Title I Dislocated Worker

distributions to Local Designated Areas for planning purposes.

Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (WIA); Department of Labor Appropriations Act, 2012, Title I of Division F of the Consolidated Appropriation Act, 2012, P.L. 112-74; Continuing Appropriations Act, 2013, P.L. 112-175; WIA Final Rule, 20 Code of Federal Regulations Parts 660-671; Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act, as amended P.L. 99-177; Budget Control Act of 2011, P.L. 112-25; Full-Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2013, Title I of Division F and Division G of the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2013, P.L. 113-6, signed 3/26/13; Nebraska Five-Year Integrated State Plan (7/1/12 – 6/30/17); TEN 27-12; TEGL 21-12; TEGL 25-12, and TEGL 24-13.

SUBSTANCE:

The State received the following allotments:

Title I Adult	[CFDA 17.258]	1,821,995
Title I Dislocated Worker	[CFDA 17.278]	<u>1,779,828</u>
Total		\$5,759,225

The allotment levels for the WIA Dislocated Worker Program Year 2013 "advance" funds have been adjusted due to recapture and reallotment provisions of WIA (20 CFR 667.150). The recapture/reallotment will apply to the FY 2014 advance portion of the PY2013 allotment that was issued in October 2013. This Issuance distributes the excess Dislocated Worker funds for planning purposes.

With TEGL 24-13, the State's Title 1 Youth and Adult allotments were not changed. However, the Dislocated Worker allotment was increased by \$99 and is now:
