For families larger than 6:

For **Nebraska Counties** (not included in the Metropolitan Statistical Areas below): add **\$4,999** per each additional person.

For Lincoln Metropolitan Statistical Area (Lancaster & Seward Counties):

- add \$5,147 per each additional person.

For **Omaha-Council Bluffs Metropolitan** Statistical Area (Washington, Douglas, Sarpy, Cass, and Saunders Counties in Nebraska and Harrison, Pottawattamie, and Mills Counties in Iowa):

- add \$5,147 per each additional person.

For Sioux City Metropolitan Statistical Area (Dixon and Dakota Counties in Nebraska & Union County in South Dakota & Woodbury County in Iowa):

- add \$5,147 per each additional person.
