Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Issuance

- **TO:** Chief Elected Officials, Local Workforce Development Board Chairs, and Providers
- **SUBJECT:** Restoration of previously reduced U.S. Department of Labor WIOA Title I Adult and Dislocated Worker Fiscal Year 2016 "advance funds" allocations for Program Year 2015 (July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016)
- **NUMBER:** 14-07, Change 2
- **PURPOSE:** This issuance serves as official notification of the restoration WIOA Title I Adult and Dislocated Worker Fiscal Year 2016 "advance funds" allocations for Program Year 2015 which were reduced in accordance with TEGL 29-14 Change 3 and Issuance No. 14-07 Change 1. Worksheets used for determining the restoration are provided as Attachments A and B and Grant Modification No. 4 from the U.S. Department of Labor is provided as Attachment C.
- **REFERENCES:** Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA); Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (WIA); Grant Modification No. 4, Grant Number AA-26793-15-55-A-31; TEGL 29-14 Change 3; Nebraska Five-Year Integrated State Plan (July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2017).
- **SUBSTANCE:** On February 17, 2016, the U.S. Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration issued Grant Modification No. 4 regarding the restoration of WIOA Title I Adult and Dislocated Worker Fiscal Year 2016 "advance funds" allocations for Program Year 2015, which were reduced by 0.2108 percent in accordance with TEGL 29-14 Change 3.

Grant Modification No. 4 restores the 0.2108 percent of the Fiscal Year 2016 "advance funds" (funding available October 2015) for the Adult and Dislocated Worker programs.
