## Upskill and Diversify Your Workforce

The Nebraska Workforce System has several programs to diversify and upskill an employer's workforce.

Businesses can:

- receive a substantial wage subsidy for hiring and training individuals from a variety of targeted populations. Individuals from these targeted populations are even eligible to have the cost of formal education and credentials paid for.
- access the Worker Training Grant to upskill their current workforce in any subject or program that increases retention, upward mobility, and productivity.

## Engage in Long-Term Workforce Planning

The Nebraska Workforce System leads sector strategies and career pathway initiatives - regional, industry-focused approaches to workforce and economic development. Placing efforts on workforce development is securing the future.

The Nebraska Department of Labor (NDOL), in partnership with the United States Department of Labor (USDOL), work with a common goal of expanding a variety of Registered Apprenticeship opportunities throughout the state. In addition to Registered Apprenticeship, employers can develop a pre-apprenticeship with NDOL in order to engage and excite students through career exploration. Employers can take this engagement further by developing a Registered Apprenticeship tailored to their unique needs, industry and occupational standards, all while receiving federal recognition from the USDOL Office of Apprenticeship as a high quality workforce development program.

## Connect with Local Workforce Development Partners

Nebraska Department of Labor business services representatives are connected to a variety of local workforce development partners. These partners include American Job Centers, government agencies such as the Department of Economic Development, local community colleges, and area non-profits. Business services representatives can connect you to partners in your area that can help you achieve your workforce development needs.
